

DRESS CODE

Our goal is to provide an atmosphere that is safe and appropriate for all students. We believe that when we dress appropriately we behave appropriately.

Therefore we are asking for a distinction between school clothes and play clothes.

Clothing should be clean and not torn.

The following is in addition to the School District dress code.

We suggest jeans or khaki's.

Sweatpants are only appropriate if they are solid color with no writing. If you can wear it to bed don't wear it to school.

All pants must go to the waist.

Skirts and shorts must be longer than the fingertips.

Tops / shirts must be a minimum of a two inch strap on the shoulder and must have an appropriately high neckline.

No skin may be exposed between top and pants regardless of the position (bending, stretching, etc)

Writing or graphics may not be sarcastic, sexual, vulgar, lewd or indecent. It may not depict the use of tobacco, alcohol or illegal substances.

Flip-flops and thin sandals are not safe for school and are not to be worn. Gym shoes or others tied or secured with Velcro should be worn to school.

Hair color may only be colors that are natural for hair. We know that some girls at the 5th and 6th grade level may want to begin experimenting with makeup; however, it is not appropriate for school at the elementary level and should be saved for events outside of school.
