I. Bedding, etc.

- 1 sleeping bag or heavy blanket
- 1 pillow
- 1 pillow case
- 2 bath towels
- 2 washcloths

All cabins and meeting areas are heated. The sleeping facilities have washrooms in the buildings.

II. Clothing

- 1 jacket
- 1 heavy sweater or sweatshirt
- 2 pairs of good walking shoes or tennis shoes (a must!)
- 1 rain coat or poncho

- 1 hat/scarf/earmuffs
- 4 or 5 pair of socks
- 1 pair of pajamas
- 2 extra pair of jeans /pants
- 1 pair of gloves
