Last Day of School

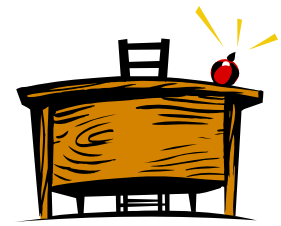
The last day of school is Wednesday, June 10th. The school day will be one hour and run from 8:30am – 9:30am.

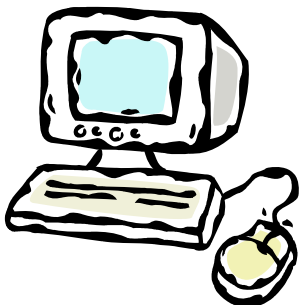
